11 - 13 July 26 - August 13	Unit 4 – My body Students will learn to name parts of the body, identify and talk about parts of the body. Students will also use regular plurals (arms) and irregular plurals (feet)	Student book p.44-53 Workbook p.40-49
14 - 16 August 16 - September 3	Unit 5 – Pets Students will identify and describe pets. Students will also use the verbs 'have' and 'be'. Students will also use an adjective plus a noun e.g. a small parrot.	Student book p.56-65 Workbook p.50-59
