Semester 1 Course Schedule		
Introduction May 17 - May 21	Students will spend the first week becoming familiar with class routines, rules and other systems. They will get to know and become comfortable with their teacher and classmates. They will also complete the welcome section of the student book and workbook.	
Unit 1 – Adventure Camp May 24 – June 11	Over the course of the next three weeks, students will work on the unit titled "Adventure Camp". During this unit students will learn to use vocabulary related to camping. They will also learn to describe people's skills and abilities.	
Unit 2 – Wildlife Park June 14 – July 2	Over the course of the next three weeks, students will work on the unit titled "Wildlife Park". During this unit students will practice describing different animals. They will also learn to compare them using comparative and superlative adjectives.	
Unit 3 – Where We Live July 5 – 23	Over the course of the next three weeks, students will work on the unit titled "Where We Live". During this unit students will describe different places. They will also learn to give directions and distinguish between things they want to do or have to do.	

Unit 4 – Good and Bad Days July 26 – Aug 13	Over the course of the next three weeks, students will work on the unit titled "Good Days and Bad Days". During this unit students will learn about international food dishes. They will also learn to use past simple tense with did and didn't.	
Unit 5 - Trips Aug 16 – Sep 3	Over the course of unit five, students will be learning to talk about trips. During this unit students will learn about different types of tourist attractions. They will also practice using both past simple tense and future tense.	
Year Review & Project Weeks Sep 6- 17	Students will end the semester by reviewing work covered already and completing a project linked to a topic that they have already studied this semester.
